Security Rules:

- Must be pre-registered
- No walk-ins or substitutions allowed
- Must be a U.S. citizen
- Must have valid photo identification
- Drivers must show current vehicle registration *and* current driver's license
- No camera's, no phones, PDA's with cameras, or recording devices are allowed

Inclement Weather Policy:

- Current weather forecasts for the ARL area are predicting only the possibility of rain or light snow for Monday afternoon, and Tuesday. It is unlikely that we will have a weather delay or weather cancellation.

Directions to ARL Adelphi Center

From points north: Take I-95 south towards Washington. Take Exit 29B (Calverton).

Stay on Powder Mill Road for approximately 2.5 miles. ARL is located on the right, at the fifth traffic light.

From the Capital Beltway (I-495): Take exit 28A (New Hampshire Avenue/North White Oak).

Turn right on to Powder Mill Road, just past the Hillendale Shopping Center.

Make a left at the first traffic light. ARL is located on the left, at the next traffic light.

Parking: Parking will be in the K-lot with shuttle vans available for transport to the Harry Diamond Building (205).

Again, drivers must show a current driver's license and vehicle registration to drive onto the ARL installation.
